Under Article (7) Seven of the NP-4 Bargaining Unit Contract; the Union is respectfully requesting a clear and thorough listing of any and all 'overt' and/or 'covert' surveillances that the Department of Correction conducted in partnership with any other State Agency or did alone; to encompass those surveillances which were carried out under the authority of any part or division of the Department of Correction up to and including the auspices of the "Security Division" and said listing to also be inclusive of any surveillances that may or may not have been sanctioned and carried out in whole or in any part by the appropriate authorities; from January of 2003 to present. Please also provide specifics for each entry as delineated below.

- 1.) **Full name of individual(s) being observed.**
- 2.) **Date Surveillance was initiated.**
- 3.) **Date Surveillance completed (If still in progress indicate that where applicable).**
- 4.) **Assigned Identification number where applicable.**
- 5.) **Assigned Investigation number where applicable.**
- 6.) **Indicate full initiative behind each surveillance performed. By this we mean who participated, who authorized, what division/dept/agency participated, why was surveillance initiated, and lastly where did said surveillance(s) take place (Give all locations where applicable).**
- 7.) **Discipline resulting from and what it was exactly; for each individual observed (Indicate none where applicable).**
- 8.) **Where applicable, please also provide any and all license plates retrieved/photographed/noted from said surveillances and indicate for each whether or not these plate identification numbers were or were not run through the system.**

Your efforts to collect and provide the aforementioned information in a timely manner would be most helpful and most appreciated. Any customary costs resulting from this request will be paid by the Union upon written request. When corresponding in any way about this particular request; please note on or refer to the Identification # assigned to same (see above). If you have any questions or concerns relative to this request; please feel free to contact June at the office.
